PROJECTS AIMS

The East of England Neonatal ODN and Regional Maternity team are starting a new project focusing on raising awareness of neonatal families in maternity services. We would like to invite parents to join a small working group to ensure their views are included. We will then work in collaboration with staff and other stakeholders to co-produce and implement an initiative across the region to support staff and families. For context, during our in-person listening events, a theme of feedback was identified that neonatal parents felt that staff working in maternity services were not always aware that their baby was in neonatal care. This would lead to staff approaching parents asking to weigh their baby, obtain observations, ask about breastfeeding. Parents reported that this caused a negative impact on their mental health and meant they needed to repeat the current situation time and time again.

We would love to have parent involvement from the beginning of the project to ensure we have parent views and perspectives included. We hope that by being involved, you will feel that you have supported the improvement of experiences for neonatal families, when in receiving maternity postnatal care.
